

School Based Traineeship in Certificate II in Agriculture

Who can apply? Year 10 students of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent.

Job role – work with the farm manager of a high school to assist in caring for livestock or in plant production.

The successful applicant will:

- Have an interest in working with animals or plants
- Have an interest in exploring agriculture as a career pathway
- Commit to complete Years 11 and 12
- Be aware of their responsibilities as an employee of the Department of Education including confidentiality and work place conduct

SBAT Requirements & Outcomes

- Complete 100 days of paid work in a host high school starting Term 4, Year 10.
- Attend training in Certificate II in Agriculture
- Gain 4 units of credit towards the HSC (this course may contribute towards an ATAR)
- On successful completion, receive the HSC, a nationally recognised qualification in Certificate II in Agriculture and a Certificate of Proficiency

- ✓ If you are selected, you will be required to attend an interview
