Who can apply? Year 10 students of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent.

Job role - Provide assistance and support to teachers and staff as they facilitate children's learning in a pre-school.

The successful applicant will:

- Have an interest in working with children in a pre-school setting
- Have an interest in exploring early childhood education as a career pathway
- Commit to complete Years 11 and 12
- Be aware of their responsibilities as an employee of the Department of Education including confidentiality and work place conduct

SBAT Requirements & Outcomes

- Complete 100 days of paid work in a host pre-school starting Term 4, Year 10.
- Attend training in Cert III Early Childhood Education & Care
- Gain 8 units of credit towards the HSC (this is a non-ATAR course)
- On successful completion, receive the HSC, a nationally recognised qualification in Certificate III in Early Childhood Education & Care and a Certificate of Proficiency

- ✓ If you are selected, you will be required to attend an interview
