Who can apply? Year 10 students of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent.

Job role - Provide assistance and support to teachers as they facilitate students' learning in a primary school.

The successful applicant will:

- Have an interest in working with children in a school setting
- Have an interest in exploring education as a career pathway
- Commit to complete Years 11 and 12
- Be aware of their responsibilities as an employee of the Department of Education including confidentiality and work place conduct

SBAT Requirements & Outcomes

- Complete 100 days of paid work in a host primary school starting Term 4, Year 10
- Attend training in Cert III Education Support (CHC30213), delivered by TAFE
- Gain 7 units of credit towards their HSC (this is a non-ATAR course)
- On successful completion, receive their HSC, a nationally recognised qualification in Certificate III in Education Support and a Certificate of Proficiency
